Points of Interest	The existing area was a natural turf ball game area that was the only green space within the school site. Due to the amount of use on the area the ground suffered from severe erosion and was out of commission in periods of inclement weather. To maximise the space for the MUGA the existing macadam tennis courts were relocated 4m towards the school boundary and the MUGA was designed to follow the irregular shape of the natural grass footprint.
